- To attend vessel and supervise the cargo operation whenever critical shipments going to be loaded to vessel.
- To source and purchase materials required for cargo operation.
- Perform cost control procedures and verify invoices
- Liaison with the Chartering Team & Post Fixture Team
- Verifying the Laytime Calculations for accuracy.
- Providing input for procedure / process improvement.
