- Coordinating releasing of bills of lading, re-documentation and switching of bills of lading when necessary.
- Serve delivery & redelivery notice as per CP.
- Monitor vessel's movement and performance daily.
- Liaise with brokers, chartering and operations department pertaining to day-to-day voyage issues.
- Liaise with legal and insurance department on disputed cases.
- Settlement of commissions with brokers.
- Charterer's and owner's reporting
- Coordinating agency appointments, reviewing and verifying PDAs and FDAs.
- Communicating with charterers, brokers, agents and vessels regarding voyage orders, vessel itineraries etc.
- Reviewing cargo stowage, loading & unloading sequences, cargo hold cleaning plans
